# Studies and Data Collection

## EuMAR: European Monitoring of Medically Assisted Reproduction

**EuMAR** is a three-year project aiming to develop a **European registry of cycle-by-cycle data** on the use and outcomes of MAR treatments.

- **Funding programme:** EU4Health
- **Total funding:** 1,880,517 €
  - EU contribution: 1,128,310 €

### Main objectives:

- 1** CREATE A DATA FLOW SYSTEM for data submission that is suitable to all stakeholders

# Exceptional financial income/expenditure

Since the start of the investment portfolio (December 2013), an implicit capital gain had been built-up. However, this added value was never expressed in the accounts.

The composition of the portfolio (at bank Delen) was changed in the course of 2021 and part of the funds were sold, this implicit added value was “locked” and was included in the accounts as income.

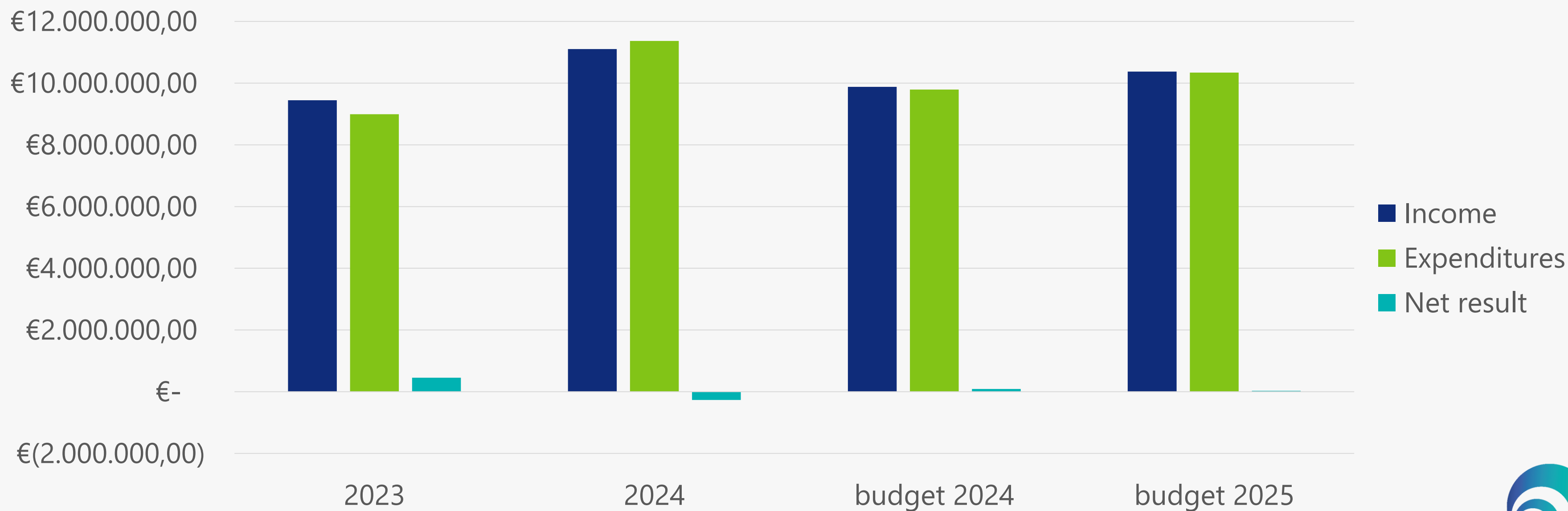
For 2024, this resulted in an exceptional financial income of 4.526,79 Euro 2024 ,which is included in the P&L result -345.861,61 Euro.

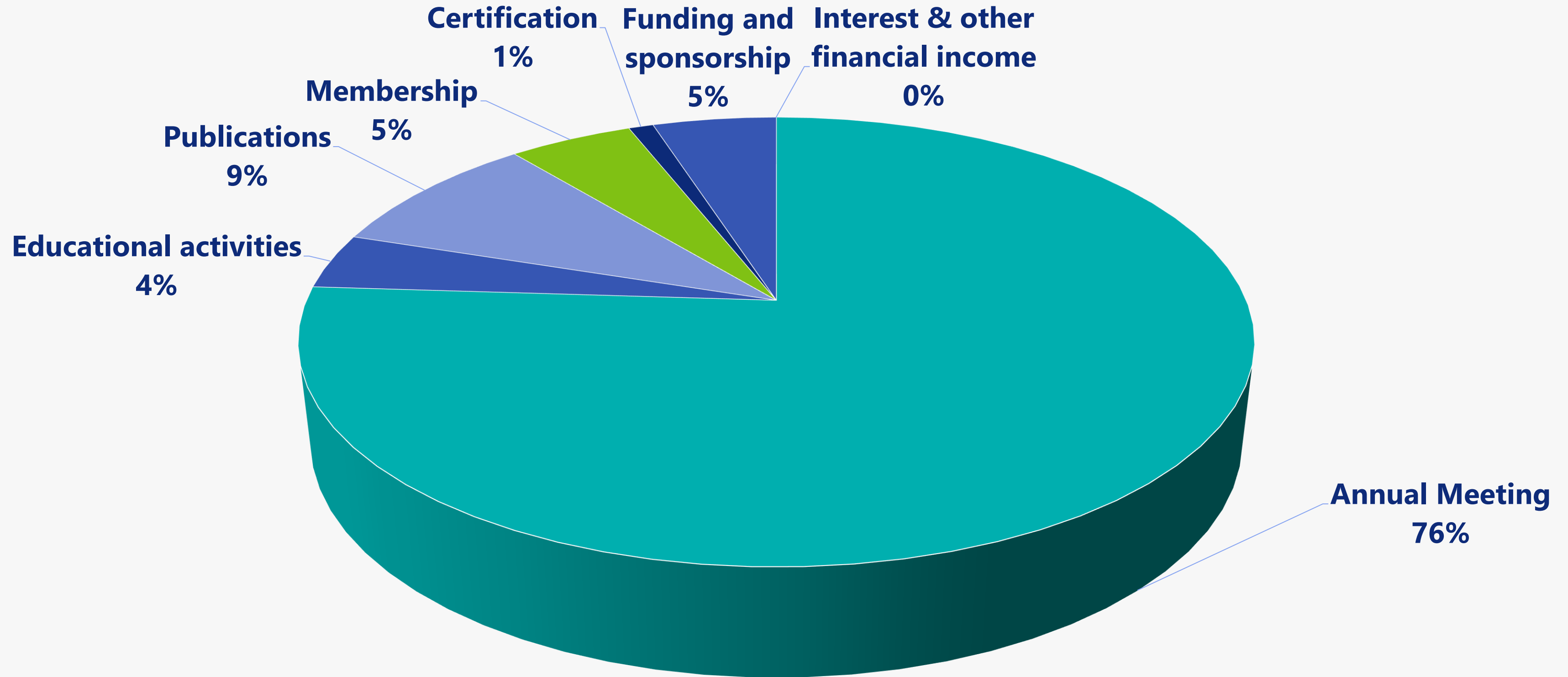

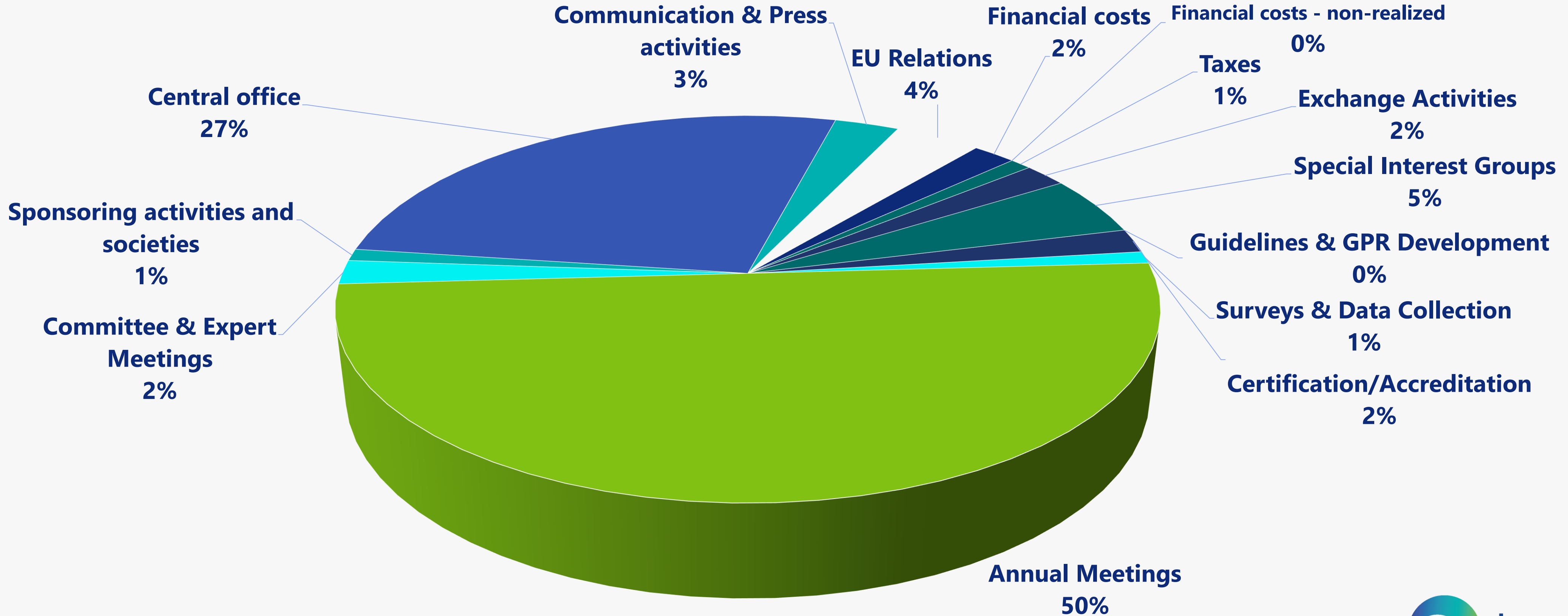

## Expenditure





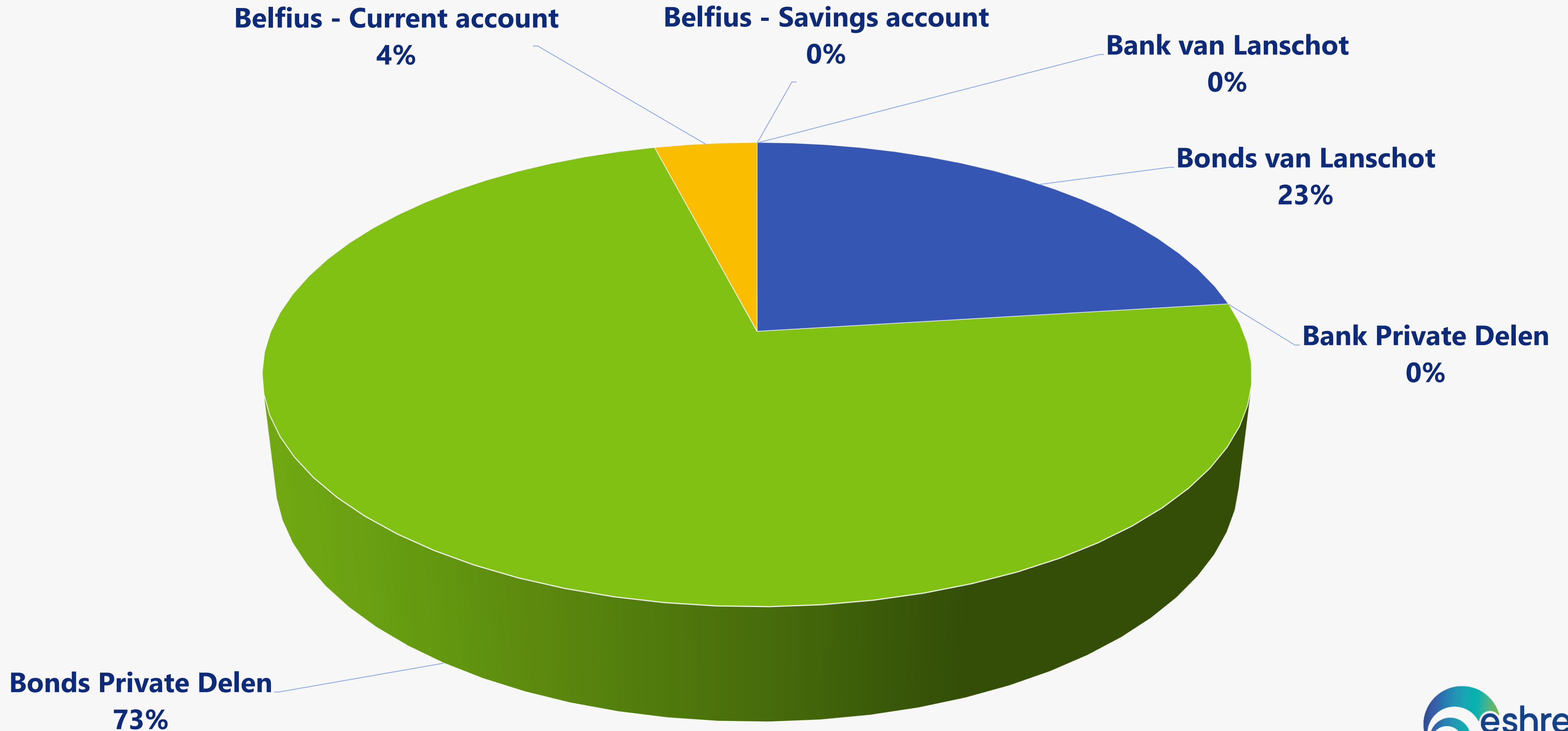
